TRASH GUIDELINES—PLEASE FOLLOW THEM



By City code you are NOT to set trash out before 4 PM on Monday and Thursdays. DO NOT set out any trash after the trash men have come.

Any trash stored outside between pickup must be in a trash can with a tight fitting lid.

Small branches need to be **bundled & tied**. Branches not longer than 4 ft. and 3 1/2 inches in diameter for pick up. You may use plain trash can, but **NO LEAVES OR YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS!** It will not be collected.

Old chemicals, TVs, computer monitors, old phones, etc. . . . these need to be taken to the House-

hold Hazardous Waste collection at the Manassas Transfer Station: 8305 Quarry Road. The dates for this are July 6, August 3, Sept. 7, Oct. 5, and Dec. 7 of 2013 from 8AM to noon and there is no cost to city residents.

TVs will not be picked up w/ the trash because they have hazardous materials in them. **DO NOT set them curbside**. Breaking them can cause harm to children. **You can also take TVs to Best Buy if they are 32" or less**. Just take it to customer service to be recycled.

Big items like furniture can be set out for **Fridays** collection only.

COMMUNITY GARDEN PLOTS STILL AVAILABLE...GET YOURS NOW!

The 2014 growing season is here! All available plots have been tilled, compost has been added, and are ready for you to start growing.

Each plot is 15x20ft and water is supplied. We also work closely with Master Gardener, Paul Gibson, who is available to answer all your gardening questions. In addition free gardening classes are available.

The cost is \$25 per plot plus an additional \$60 to cover the cost of tilling/compost. The 2014 application and agreement form is available on our website at www.pointofwoodshoa.com.

You do not have to live in POW 1&2 to rent a plot. Plots are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. So if you have your eye on a certain plot, you must turn in your money and application before you can claim it.
