GET YOUR NEW HANG TAGS SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 15TH

To ensure that dues are being paid and that there are no extra hang tags floating around causing parking issues for everyone, we are issuing new parking passes.

We have scheduled the day for pickup on Saturday, September 15, 2012, from 10:30am—12:45pm at Central Library.

If you cannot make it on this day, you will need to make other arrangements prior to the pick up date.

Regardless of when you pick up your new hang tags, <u>all old hang tags</u> will be void as of Mon. Sept. 24, 2012 at 12am. Anyone parked with

old hang tags after this time will be towed.

To obtain new hang tags you must bring your old hang tags, photo ID, lease (if you rent), and payment for any assessment fees you owe.

TRASH PICKUP

Trash pickup is on Tuesdays and Fridays. Trash should be placed out no earlier than 4:30 pm on Monday and Thursday.

Recycling is also collected on Tuesdays and may also be put out Mondays no earlier than 4:30 pm.

ASSESSMENT FEES

Annual assessment fees are \$464 and are payable quarterly at \$116. Payment due dates are Jan 1, Apr 1, Jul 1 and Oct 1. Payments are considered late if not received by the 30th of the month due.

Past due balances are subject to a late fee of \$25.00 and interest of 6% APR, both applied quarterly.

PARKING & TOWING

Any vehicle parked in a lot without a hang tag will be subject to towing. If you are delinquent on your assessment fees, your parking privileges will be suspended until any amount owed is paid in full.
